acquaints readers with Muslim and Christian intellectuals, bureaucrats, and theologians, and concludes by exploring Darwin's waning influence on public and intellectual life in the Arab world after World War I. *Reading Darwin in Arabic* is an engaging and powerfully argued reconceptualization of the intellectual and political history of the Middle East.
